

County Surveyor's Record, Douglas County, Oregon

Resurvey of E. Bdy. of T. 32 S., R. 3 W.

CHAINS

- 31.50 Gulch, course NW.
- 39.10 Intersect the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., between secs. 13 and 18, which is a fir, 14 ins. diam., marked and witnessed as described by the Surveyor General.
- The course of this line is North and the length is 39.10 chs.
- Commencing at the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., I run North between secs. 13 and 18. Continue measurement.
- 4.25 Creek, 7 lks. wide, course W. Ascend SE. slope.
- 23.80 Summit of ridge bears E. and W.
- Descend N. slope to Cow Creek.
- 39.90 The cor. to secs. 7, and 18, which is an ironstone, 12x10x6 ins., above ground, firmly set and marked and witnessed as described by the surveyor general.
- The course of this line is North and the length is 39.90 chs.
- Land, mountainous.
- Soil, loam and stony, second and third rate.
- Timber, red fir, sugar and yellow pine, cedar, laurel.
- Undergrowth, arrow-wood, hazel, chinquapin, laurel.
- Mountainous or heavily timbered land or land covered with dense undergrowth, 79.00 chs.
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- The line between secs. 1 and 12 being out of limits with the reported length of the N. bdy. of sec. 1, and the line between secs. 1 and 2 being out of limits with the reported length of the E. bdy. of sec. 1, I commence at the cor. of secs. 6 and 7, on the W. bdy. of T 32 S R 2 W, which is an ironstone, 10x5x5 ins. above ground, firmly set and marked and witnessed as described by the surveyor general.
- Thence, I run North, on W. bdy. of sec. 6.
- Over mountainous land, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth. Descend NW. slope.
- 7.95 Beaver, creek, 5 lks. wide, course SW. Ascend S. slope.
