

RE-SURVEY OF N BDY OF T 32 S, R 3 W.

CHAINS	
16.50	A yellow pine 30 ins diam. with 2 notches on E & W sides(?)
17.75	Trail bears N and S
24.56	Creek, 4 lks., wide, course S.
	Asc. SW slope
32.50	Summit of ridge bears N and S.
	Desc. E slope.
40.50	Intersect the cor. of Tps 31 S, Rs 2 and 3 W, already described.
	The course of this line is East and the length in 40.40 chs.
	I destroy this corner and in its original position establish cor for T 31 S, R 3 W, as follows:
	Set a fir post 3 ft long, 5 ins., sp, 24 ins in the ground for SE cor of T 31 S, R 3 W, marked
	S 1 on NE,
	T 32 S R 3 W S 1 on SE,
	S 1 on SW and
	T 31 S R 3 W S 36 on NW face, with 6 notches on N and W edges; from which
	A white fir 30 ins diam bears N.55°W. 87 lks. dist. marked T 31 S R 3 W S 36 ET
	No stones obtainable.
	Land, mountainous.
	Soil, loam and stony, 2nd and 3d rate.
	Timber, red and white fir, yellow and sugar pine, cedar, laurel, undergrowth, laurel, manzanita, chinkapin, hemlock.
	Mountainous or heavily timbered land or land covered with dense undergrowth, 82.28 chs.
