

Retracement-Reestablishment of Subdivision Lines of T. 32 S. R. 3 W.

CHAINS

- 56.00 Ravine. course NE.
- 62.25 Spur. slopes NE.
- 68.25 Ridge, bears NW. and SE. Descend South slope.
- 78.32 Intersect the cor. of Secs. 14, 15, 22 and 23, which is a decayed post, marked as described by the Surveyor General.
- The NW. bearing tree remains; the other bearing trees are dead and fallen. I destroy this cor. and reestablish it in the same place, for the cor. of Secs. 14 and 15 only, as follows:
- Set a granite stone, 15x8x6 ins., 10 ins. in the ground, for cor. of Secs. 14 and 15 only, marked with 2 notches on East edge, from which
- A Fir, 30 ins. diam., bears N.60°E., 52 lks. dist., marked T 32 S R 3 W S 14 B T.
- A Fir, 40 ins. diam., bears N.70°W., 18 lks. dist., marked T 32 S R 3 W S 15 B T.
- Land. mountainous.
- Soil. decomposed granite; third rate.
- Timber, Fir, Hemlock, Cedar and Madrone.
- Undergrowth. Rhododendron, Madrone and Arrowwood.
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- From the cor. of Secs. 10, 11, 14 and 15. I retrace East, between Secs. 11 and 14, and at 38.74 chs. fall 32 lks. South of the $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. cor.
- Thence I continue the retracement E. and at 39.85 chs. fall 18 lks. S. of the cor. of Secs. 11, 12, 13 and 14.
- Thence I run
- S.89°44'W. on a true line, between Secs. 11 and 14.
- Ascend NE. slope, through scattering timber and dense undergrowth.
- 0.50 Ridge, divide between Cow and Applegate creeks, bears NW. and SE. Descend SW. slope.
- 26.55 Ravine, course SW.
