

Retracement-Reestablishment of Subdivision Lines of T.32 S., R.3 W.

CHAINS	<p>Leave scattering timber, bears NE. and SW.</p> <p>Enter dense thickets of Lilac, Manzanita and Madrona.</p> <p>37.60 Spur, slopes South. Descend SW. slope.</p> <p>39.15 Ravine, course South. Ascend SE. slope.</p> <p>39.85 Intersect the $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. cor., which is a mound of stone, the post having been destroyed by fire. I reestablish this cor. in its original position as follows:</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">Set a granite stone, 18x15x4 ins., 12 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on North face, from which</p> <p style="padding-left: 80px;">A Madrona, 5 ins. diam., bears N.88*30'E., 100 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S.11 B T.</p> <p style="padding-left: 80px;">A Madrona, 5 ins. diam., bears S.78*30'E., 119 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 14 B T.</p> <p>I continue my line,</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">S.89*32'W., on a true line, between Secs. 11 and 14.</p> <p>45.60 Spur, slopes SW. Along West slope.</p> <p>56.85 Spur, slopes NW. Leave thickets; enter scattering timber and dense undergrowth, bears NW. and SE. Descend NW. slope.</p> <p>76.20 Spur, slopes SW. Descend West slope.</p> <p>78.59 The cor. of Secs. 10, 11, 14 and 15.</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">Land, mountainous, steep slopes.</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">Soil, decomposed granite; third rate.</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">Timber, Fir, Madrona and Pinon.</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">Undergrowth, Manzanita, Lilac, Arrowwood and Madrona.</p> <p style="text-align: right; padding-right: 40px;">September 17, 1913.</p>
	<p>At the cor. of secs. 14 and 15.</p> <p>Thence I run</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">West, retracing the S. bdy. of sec. 15.</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">Ascend SE. slope, through dense timber and undergrowth.</p> <p>3.30 Spur, slopes S. Descend SW. slope.</p> <p>5.35 Ravine course S. Ascend SE. slope.</p>
