North, between Secs. 16 and 17. At 40.00 chs. after careful search, I find no trace of the $\frac{1}{2}$ Sec. cor., and at 81.43 chs. fall 132 lks. East of the cor. of Secs. 8. 9, 16 and 17.

The cor. of Secs. 8. 9. 16 and 17 is located by reference to the NE., SE., and NW. bearing trees. All traces of the cor. and the SW. tree have disappeared.

I reestablish the cor. in its original position as follows:

Set a granite stone. 15x12x4 ins., 10 ins. in the ground, for cor. of Secs. 8, 9, 16 and 17. marked with 4 notches on South and East edges; from which

A Pinon. 14 ins. diam., bears N7*30'E., 72 lks. dist., marked T 32 S R 3 W S 9 B T.

A Pinon. 12 ins. diam., bears S. 43*E. 160 lks. dist., marked T 32 S R 3 W S 16 P T.

A Pinon. 6 ins. diam., bears S.1*W., 69 lks. dist., marked T 32 S R 3 W S 17 B T.

A Pinon, 14 ins. diam., bears N.3*30'W.. 65 lks. dist., marked T 32 S R 3 W S 8 B T.
