	<p>At the cor. of Secs. 28, 29, 32 and 33. Thence I run</p> <p>West, on a Sectional Correction line, between Secs. 29 and 32.</p> <p>Ascend NE. slope, through dense timber and undergrowth.</p> <p>4.00 Spur, slopes NE. Along North slope.</p> <p>9.40 Spur, slopes NW. Descend NW. slope.</p> <p>20.85 Gaulaway Gap trail, Cow creek to Evans creek, bears North and South.</p> <p>21.10 West Fork of Applegate creek, 10 lks. wide, course North. Ascend East slope.</p> <p>23.45 Spur, slopes SE.</p> <p>31.40 Creek, 3 lks. wide, course SE. Ascend SE. slope.</p> <p>75.65 High ridge, Umpqua divide, bears North and South. Along South slope.</p> <p>80.00 Set a serpentine stone, 18 x 8 x 8 ins., 12 ins. in the ground, for cor. of Secs. 29, 30, 31 and 32, marked with 1 notch on South and 5 notches on East edge, from which</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">A Fir, 15 ins. diam., bears N.51*E., 46 lks. dist., marked T. 32 S R 3 W S 29 B T.</p>
