CHAINS

Land, Mountainous.

Soil, decomposed granite; 3rd rate.

Timber, fir and sugar pine.

Undergrowth, rhododendron, vine maple and lilac.

October 9: At the cor. of secs. 28, 29, 32 and 33.

Thence I run

S. 0° 02' E., on a random line, bet. secs. 32 and 33.

40.00 Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

80.00 Intersect the 7th stand. Par. South, 1 lk. W. of the
 Stand. cor. of secs. 32 and 33.

Thence I run

N. 0° 2' W., on a true line, bet. secs. 32 and 33.

Descend NE. slope, from Skeleton Mountain, through dense
 timber and undergrowth.

10.40 Pluff, 40 ft. high, bears E. and W.

25.65 Creek, 2 lks. wide, course NE.

32.40 Spur, slopes NE.

33.75 Ravine, course NE.

35.80 Spur, slopes NE.

40.00 Set a serpentine stone, 18x8x5 ins., 12 ins. in the
 ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on W. face; from which

A fir, 24 ins. diam., bears N. 78° E., 47 lks. dist.,
 marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 33 B T.

A fir, 20 ins. diam., bears S. 54° W., 10 lks, dist.,
 marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 32 B T.

42.60 Creek, 3 lks. wide, course NW. Along W. slope.

54.00 Spur, slopes NW.

59.00 Spur, slopes NW. Descend NW. slope.

61.95 Ravine, course NW.

71.00 Creek, 1 lk. wide, course W.
