## CHAINS

- 79.00 Ridge, divide bet. Applegate and Dismal creeks, bears E. and W.
- 80.00 Set a granite stone, 20x8x6 ins., 15 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 20, 21, 28 and 29, marked with 2 notches on S. and 4 notches on E. edge; from which
- A fir, 30ins.diam., bears N. 12\* E., 40 lks. dist., marked T 32 S R 3 W S 21 B T.
- A madrona, 12 ins.diam., bears S. 53\* E., 27 lks. dist., marked T 32 S R 3 W S 28 B T.
- A chinquapin, 16 ins.diam., bears S. 58\* W., 50 lks. dist., marked T 32 S R 3 W S 29 B T.
- A sugar pine, 40 ins.diam., bears N. 5\* W., 69 lks. dist., marked T 32 S R 3 W S 20 B T.
- Land, mountainous.
- Soil, decomposed granite; erd rate.
- Timber, fir, sugar pine, madrona and chinquapin.
- Undergrowth, fir, arrowwood and yew.
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- East, on a random line, bet secs. 21 and 28.
- 40.00 Set temp.  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor.
- 79.60 Intersect N. and S. line, 21 lks. S. of the cor. of secs. 21, 22, 27 and 28.
- Thence I run
- S. 89\* 51' W., on a true line, bet. secs. 21 and 28, Ascend NE. slope, through dense timber and undergrowth.
- 1.25 Summit of slight rise. Descend SW. slope.
- 3.75 Red Mountain trail, bears NW. and SE.
- 7.35 Creek, 10 lks. wide, course NW. Along N. slope.
- 10.90 Wagon road, bears NW. and SE.
- 17.25 Trail, bears N. and S.
- 18.20 Applegate creek, 16 lks. wide, course N. 30\* E., ascend E. slope.
