18.60	Trail, bears N. and S.
26.50	Spur, slopes S. Descend SW. slope.
28.35	Creek, 1 lk. wide, course SE. Ascend E. slope.
39.80	Set a granite stone, 14x8x6 ins., 10 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on N. face; from which <div style="margin-left: 40px;">A fir, 14 ins.diam., bears N. 62* E., 41 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 21 B T. A fir, 14 ins.diam., bears S. 84* E., 91 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 28 B T.</div>
41.00	Spur, slopes S. Along S. slope
43.30	Spur, slopes S. Descend W. slope.
45.45	Ravine, course S. Ascend SE. slope.
58.60	Ridge, divide bet. Applegate and Dismal creeks at angle bears NE. and W.; thence along ridge.
66.00	Leave ridge, bears SW. Along N. slope.
79.60	The cor. of secs. 20, 21, 28 and 29. Land, mountainous. Soil, decomposed granite; 3rd rate. Timber, fir, sugar pine, and madrona. Undergrowth, lilac, arrowwood, fir and madrona. <div style="text-align: right;">Oct. 15, 1913.</div>
