62.10	Stream, 3 lks. wide, C. N 70°W.
80.00	Set post corner of secs. 18, 19, 13 and 24, from which, A Laurel, 10 ins. diam., bears N. 14°W., 61 lks. A Laurel, 4 ins. diam., bears N. 16°E., 71 lks.
