 A Laurel, 3 ins. diam., bears N.7°W., 58 lks.
 Land, N. slope of mountain, and stoney.
 Timber, Fir, etc., part burnt and fallen.

 54.00 Leave brush thicket and enter Fir timber.
 54.00 Foot of steep descent C. E. & W.
 61.28 A Fir, 30 ins. diam.
 75.30 To a stream, 20 lks. wide, C. W.
 75.30 Commence gradual ascent on NW. slope.
 80.00 Set post corner of secs. 30, 31, 25 and 36, from which,
 A Fir, 8 ins. diam., bears S25°W., 18 lks.
 A Fir, 12 ins. diam., bears S.50°E., 75 lks.
 A Fir, 6 ins. diam., bears N.66°E., 43 lks.
 A Hemlock, 12 ins. diam., bears N.40°W., 20 lks.
 Land, hilly.
 Soil, second rate, stoney, underlaid with Basalt slate
 and fragments of Quartz rock.
 Timber, Fir, Redwood, etc. On steep slope is a thicket
 of Laurel, Chimesal, Live Oak, Chinquapin, etc.
