notches on E. and 4 notches on W. edges; from which,  
 A Fir, 10 ins. diam., bears N.87°E., 42 lks. dist.,  
 marked T.38 S., R. 4 W., S. 26, B. T.  
 A Fir, 10 ins. diam., bears S.60°E., 27 lks. dist.,  
 marked T. 32 S., R. 4 W., S. 35, B. T.  
 A Cedar, 14 ins. diam., bears S.32°W., 25 lks. dist.,  
 marked T. 32 S., R. 4 W., S. 34, B. T.  
 A Fir, 12 ins. diam., bears N.65°W., 31 lks. dist.,  
 marked T. 32 S., R. 4 W., S. 27 B. T.

This corner is on the NE. slope of ridge, 50 ft. above  
 ravine.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, third and fourth rate.

Timber, Fir, Hemlock, Cedar, Pine and Yew.

Dense undergrowth of rhododendron, huckle-berry, salal-  
 berry and hazel.

Land, mountainous, hevily timbered or covered with

10.75 Top of mountain, 125 ft. above sec. corner; desc. along  
 N. side of ridge, bearing E. and W.

31.25 Ravine sloping N., 50 ft. below top of mountain, asc.  
 spur.

39.05 Trail to Hogum Creek, bears NW. and SE., 25 ft. above  
 ravine.

40.00 Top of spur, sloping N. 25 ft. above trail.

Set a basalt stone, 14 x 12 x 8 ins., 9 ins. in the
