CHAINS

SW. and S. 29 on NW., faces, with 4 notches on E. and 2 notches on W. edges, from which,

A Fir, 40 ins. diam., bears N.66*E., 69 lks. dist., marked T. 32 S., R. 4 W., S. 28, B. T.

A Dead Fir, 30 ins. diam., bears S.34*E., 64 lks. dist., marked T. 32 S., R. 4 W., S. 33, B. T.

A Dead Fir, 36 ins. diam., bears S. 13*W., 21 lks. dist., marked T. 32 S., R. 4 W., S. 32, B. T.

A Fir, 40 ins. diam., bears N.58*W., 92 lks. dist., marked T. 32 S., R. 4 W., S. 29, B. T.

This corner is on a steep hillside, sloping W., 25 ft. below spur.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, third and fourth rate.

Timber, Fir, Hemlock, Cedar, Pine, Chinquapin, Yew and Live Oak.

Dense undergrowth of Rhododendron, Chinquapin, Hazel Huckle-berry, and Hemlock.

Land, mountainous, heavily timbered or covered with dense undergrowth, 80.00 shs.

18.40 Wagon road, bears N.20*W., and S.20*E., 25 ft. below ditch.
