## CHAINS

Soil, third and fourth rate.

Timber, Fir, Cedar, Pine, Hemlock, Yew and Maple and Madrona.

Dense undergrowth of Rhododendron, Salal-berry, Ocean-spray, and Madrona.

Land, mountainous, heavily timbered or covered with dense undergrowth, 80.04 chs.

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North  $0^{\circ}2'W.$ , on a true line bet. secs. 14 and 15.

Asc. spur.

3.50 Top of spur, slopes SW., 50 ft. above sec. corner; desc.

26.50 Creek, 12 lks. wide, C. W., 800 ft. below top of spur.

Asc.

40.00 Set a basalt stone, 14 x 12 x 8 ins., 9 ins. in the ground for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. corner, marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  on W. face; from which,

A Fir, 16 ins. diam., bears  $N.81^{\circ}W.$ , 61 lks. dist. marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S., B. T.

A Fir, 12 ins. diam., bears  $S.47^{\circ}E.$ , 13 lks. dist., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S., B. T.

This corner is on the S. slope of mountain, 300 ft. above creek.

66.25 Top of ridge, bears NE. and SW., 600 ft. above  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. corner.

Leave green timber, bear E. and W., desc. along W. slope of spur.

80.00 Set a basalt stone, 12 x 10 x 7 ins., 8 ins. in the ground for corner of secs. 10, 11, 14 and 15, marked with 2 notches on E. and 4 notches on S. edges, from which,

A Dead Fir, 24 ins. diam., bears  $N.31^{\circ}E.$ , 78 lks. dist., marked T. 32 S., R. 4 W., S. 11, B. T.

A Dead Fir, 24 ins. diam., bears  $S.72^{\circ}E.$ , 49 lks.
