

Subdivisions, T. 32 S., R. 4 W.

CHAINS

A Fir, 24 ins. diam., bears N.83*W., 7 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{2}$ S., B. T.

This corner is on the SW. slope of spur, 25 ft. above Boulder Creek.

52.15 Top of spur, slopes NW., 25 ft. above $\frac{1}{2}$ sec. corner; desc.

54.25 Ravine, C. NW., 30 ft. below top of last spur; asc. spur.

61.00 Top of spur, slopes NW., 50 ft. above last ravine; desc.

63.25 Ravine, C. NW., 75 ft. below top of last spur; asc. spur.

66.15 Top of spur, slopes NW., 20 ft. above last ravine; desc.

68.25 Creek, 1 lks. wide, C. N.60*W., 25 ft. below top of last spur; asc. spur.

72.22 Trail, bears NW., and SE.

73.00 Top of spur, slopes NW., 50 ft. above creek; desc.

80.00 Set a Madrona post, 3 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground for corner of secs. 21, 22, 27 and 28, marked T. 32 S., S. 22 on NE., R. 4 W., S. 27 on SE., S. 28 on SW., and S. 21 on NW. faces, with 3 notches on E. and 2 notches on S. edges; from which

A Pine, 48 ins. diam., bears N.64*E., 25 lks. dist., marked T. 32 S., R. 4 W., S. 22, B. T.

A Fir, 24 ins. diam., bears S.10*E., 51 lks. dist., marked T. 32 S., R. 4 W., S. 27, B. T.

A Fir, 20 ins. diam., bears S.9*W., 26 lks. dist., marked T. 32 S., R. 4 W., S. 28, B. T.

A Fir, 48 ins. diam., bears N.60*W., 58 lks. dist., marked T. 32 S., R. 4 W., S. 21, B. T.

This corner is on the NE. slope of spur, 75 ft. below top.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, third and fourth rate.

Timber, Fir, Hemlock, Cedar, Pine, Chinquapin, Madrona and Yew.
