Dense undergrowth of Rhododendron, Vine-Maple, Ocean-spray and Chinquapin.

Land, mountainous, heavily timbered or covered with dense undergrowth, 80.00 chs.

Aug. 31, 1897.

East on a random line, bet. secs. 22 and 27.

40.00 Set a temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. corner.

79.85 Intersect N. and S. line, 18 lks. N. of the corner of secs. 22, 23, 26 and 27; thence, I run N.89°52'W., on a true line bet. secs. 22 and 27.

Desc.

11.45 Creek, 8 lks. wide, C. N.25°W., 100 ft. below sec. corner; asc.

24.00 Top of ridge, bears N. and S., 175 ft. above creek; desc.

28.75 Top of spur, slopes NW. 25 ft. below top of ridge.

39.92 A Madrona, 10 ins. diam., I mark $\frac{1}{4}$ S. on N. side, from which

A Madrona, 8 ins. diam., bears N.27°E., 40 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S., B. T.

A Fir, 20 ins. diam., bears S.29°E., 16 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S., B. T.

This $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. corner is on the SW slope, 100 ft. below top.

55.53 Creek, 3 lks. wide, C. N.10°W., 100 ft. below top of last spur; asc. spur.

57.50 Creek, 1 lk. wide, C. NE.

59.25 Top of spur, slopes NE. 50 ft. above last creek; desc.

63.00 Creek, 1 lk. wide, C. NE., 25 ft. below top of last spur; asc. spur.

72.50 Top of spur, slopes N. 50 ft. above creek; desc. into canyon.

75.75 Bottom of canyon, 50 ft. below top of spur, bears N.20°E. and S.20°W; asc.
