- 54.97 White Horse Creek, 50 lks. wide, C. N., 150 ft. below ditch. Asc.
- 56.00 Abandoned placer mine; excavation bears N. and S.
- 70.50 Top of spur, slopes S. 300 ft. above creek; desc.
Enter green timber.
- 73.25 Ravine, C. S., 25 ft. below top of last spur; asc. spur.
- 74.25 Top of spur, slopes S. 25 ft. above last ravine; desc.
- 76.25 Ravine, C. S., 25 ft. below last spur; asc. spur.
- 77.75 Top of spur, slopes S. 40 ft. above ravine; desc.
- 79.76 The corner of secs. 9, 10, 15 and 16, 50 ft. below top of last spur.
- Land, mountainous.

- 17.25 Creek, 2 lks. wide, C. SE. 25 ft. below top of last spur; asc. spur.
- 26.50 Top of spur, slopes E., 175 ft. above last creek; desc.
