CHAINS

Dense undergrowth of rhododendron, chinquapin, hemlock, fir, hazel and mountain-balm.

Mountainous land, heavily timbered or covered with dense undergrowth, 99.43 chs.

North, 0*3'W., on a true line, bet. secs. 28 and 29.

- 2.25 Ravine, slopes NW. 25 ft. below sec. corner; asc. spur.
- 3.75 Top of spur, slopes W., 50 ft. above last ravine; desc.
- 4.75 Ravine, C. W., 25 ft. below top of last spur; asc. spur.
- 17.50 Top of spur, slopes W., 100 ft. above last ravine, desc.
- 20.75 Ravine, C. W., 25 ft. below top of last spur; asc. spur.
- 28.75 Top of spur, slopes W., 100 ft. above last ravine; desc.
- 36.00 Ravine, C. NW., 75 ft. below top of last spur.
- 40.00 Thence, along hillside, sloping W.
Set a fir post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. corner, marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S on W. face; from which

A dead Fir, 24 ins. diam., bears N.42*E., 18 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.

A dead Fir, 20 ins. diam., bears N.73*W., 27 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.

Begin ascent of spur.

- 49.00 Top of spur, slopes W., 100 ft. above $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. corner; desc.
- 50.75 Ravine, C. W., 25 ft. below top of last spur; asc.
- 69.75 Top of ridge, bears S.30*E., and N.30*W., 100 ft. above ravine.

- 80.00 Set a madrona post, 3 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground for a corner of secs. 20, 21, 28 and 29, marked

T 32 S S 21 on NE., R 4 W S 28 on SE., S 29 on SW., and S 20 on NW. faces, with 2 notches on S. and 4 notches on
