CHAINS

A Fir, 20 ins. diam., bears N.75*E., 44 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{2}$ S B T.

A Fir, 24 ins. diam., bears S.87*E., 36 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{2}$ S B T.

This corner is on the N. slope of spur, 150 ft. above Boulder Creek.

- 43.00 Top of spur, slopes NW., 50 ft. above $\frac{1}{2}$ sec. corner; desc.
- 49.96 Miners' water ditch, bears NW. and SE., 100 ft. below top of spur.
- 56.55 Hogum Creek, 5 lks. wide, C. NW., 100 ft. below ditch. Miners' cabin, bears N., about 3 chs. dist., asc. spur.
- 60.00 Miners' water ditch, bears NW. and SE., 30 ft. above creek.
- 61.75 Top of spur, slopes NE., 50 ft. above ditch; desc.
- 63.00 Ravine, C. NE., 25 ft. below top of last spur; asc. spur.
- 66.00 Top of spur, slopes NE., 50 ft. above last ravine; desc.
- 74.00 Ravine, C. NE., 15 ft. below top of last spur; asc.
- 79.86 The corner of secs. 20, 21, 28 and 29, 75 ft. above ravine.
- Land, mountainous.
- Soil, third and fourth rate.
- Timber, scattering fir, cedar, pine, hemlock, madrona, maple, yew and chinquapin.
- Dense undergrowth of rhododendron, mountain-balm, chinquapin, salal-berry, thimble-berry, madrona and hazel.
