31.50	Creek, 1 lk. wide, C. S., 75 ft. below top of spur. Thence, along S. slope of mountain.
33.54	Creek, 1 lk. wide, C. S.
34.50	Creek, 1 lk. wide, C. SE., asc. spur.
38.25	Top of spur, slopes S. 50 ft. above creeks; desc.
40.09	Set a madrona post, 3 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. corner, marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S on N. face; from which A Fir, 30 ins. diam., bears N.69*E., 36 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T. A Fir, 36 ins. diam., bears S.17*E., 25 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.
	This corner is on the W. slope of spur, 50 ft. below top.
41.33	Creek, 2 lks. wide, C. S., 25 ft. below $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. corner; asc. spur.
43.90	Top of spur, slopes S. 50 ft. above last creek; desc.
45.77	Creek, 1 lk. wide, C. S., 25 ft. below top of spur; asc.
50.75	Trail, bears N. and S.
53.35	Top of ridge, bears N. and S., 100 ft. above last creek; desc.
57.50	Ravine, C. S., 50 ft. below top of ridge; asc. spur.
60.25	Top of spur, slopes S., 25 ft. above last ravine; desc.
67.75	Ravine, C. S., 75 ft. below top of last spur; asc. spur.
71.25	Spur, slopes S., 25 ft. above last ravine; desc.
73.75	Ravine, C. S., 75 ft. below top of last spur; asc. spur.
79.00	Top of spur, slopes S., 25 ft. above ravine; desc.
80.18	The corner of secs. 16, 17, 20 and 21, 25 ft. below top of last spur. Land, mountainous. Soil, third and fourth rate. Timber, fir, madrona, alder, yew, maple, chinquapin and live oak. Dense undergrowth of madrona, thimbel-berry, salal-berry,
