fir and hazel.

Mountainous land, heavily timbered or covered with dense undergrowth, 80.18 chs.

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North,  $0^{\circ}3'W.$ , on a true line, bet. secs. 16 and 17.

Ascend spur.

- 2.50 Top of spur, slopes W., 25 ft. above sec. corner; desc.
- 10.50 Spur, slopes NW., 50 ft. below top of last spur.
- 26.02 Creek, 1 lk. wide, C. NW., 200 ft. below top of last spur; asc. spur.
- 27.25 Top of spur, slopes NW. 15 ft. above last creek; desc.
- 29.54 Creek, 4 lks. wide, C. W., 40 ft. below top of last spur; asc. spur.
- 40.00 Set a pine post, 3 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. corner, marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S. on W. face; from which
  - A Fir, 8 ins. diam., bears  $S.78^{\circ}E.$ , 29 lks. dist., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S B T.
  - An Oak, 6 ins. diam., bears  $S.83^{\circ}W.$ , 6 lks. dist., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S B T.

This  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. corner is on the W. slope of spur, 100 ft. above creek.
- 47.50 Top of spur, slopes NW., 75 ft. above  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. corner; desc.
- 52.09 Creek, 1 lk. wide, C. W., 50 ft. below top of last spur; asc. spur.
- 57.75 Top of spur, slopes W., 75 ft. above creek; desc.
- 74.25 Ravine, C. SW., 50 ft. below top of last spur; asc.
- 80.00 Set a madrona post, 3 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground for a corner of secs. 8, 9, 16 and 17, marked
  - T 32 S S 9 on NE., R 4 W S 16 on SE., S 17 on SW. and S 8 on NW. faces, with 4 notches on S. and E. edges; from which
