A Fir, 66 ins. diam., bears S.15*E., 12 lks. dist.,
marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.

This corner is on the northern slope of ridge, 15 ft.
below top.

45.00 Ravine, C. NE., 25 ft. below $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. corner; asc.

61.00 Top of ridge, bears NW. and SE., 150 ft. above ravine;
desc.

80.06 The corner of secs. 8, 9, 16 and 17, 200 ft. below top
of ridge.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, third and fourth rate.

Timber, fir, madrona, maple, hemlock, yew, oak and alder.

Dense undergrowth of madrona, hazel, mountain-balm,
chinquapin and ocean-spray.

Land, mountainous, heavily timbered or covered with
dense undergrowth, 80.06 chs.

7.25 Top of ridge, bears NW. and SE., 125 ft. above sec. cor-
ner; desc.

11.08 A fir, 24 ins. diam., on line, I mark with 2 notches on
N. and S. sides.

29.00 Ravine, C. NE., 200 ft. below top of ridge; asc. spur.

32.75 Top of spur, slopes NE., 25 ft. above ravine; desc.

40.00 Set a fir post, 3 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the
ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. corner, marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S on W. face;

A Fir, 16 ins. diam., bears N.85*E., 7 lks. dist.,
marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.

A Fir, 12 ins. diam., bears N.85*W., 13 lks. dist.,
marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.
