Subdivisions, T. 32 S., R. 4 W.

CHAINS

50.28 Starvout Creek, 8 lks. wide, C. NW.

52.54 Division of Starvout Creek, 5 lks. wide, C. NW.

55.00 Leave creek bottom and asc.

66.34 Intersect N. and S. line, 10.31 chs. N.36'W. of the corner of secs. 17, 18, 19 and 20, which I reestablish as follows:

Set a fir post 3 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground for the SE. corner of sec. 18, marked T 32 S R 4 W S 18 on NW. face; from which

A Fir, 16 ins. diam., bears N.52*W., 26 lks. dist., marked T 32 S R 4 W S 18 B T.

At point of intersection, 10.31 chs. N.36'W. of this corner, I

Set a cedar post 3 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground for a closing corner of secs. 17 and 20, marked C C T 32 S R 4 W on E., S 17 on N., and S 20 on S. faces, with 5 grooves on E. and 3 grooves on S. faces; from which

A Fir, 24 ins. diam., bears N.38*E., 46 lks. dist., marked T 32 S R 4 W S 17 B T.

A Fir, 26 ins. diam., bears S.27*E., 85 lks. dist., marked T 32 S R 4 W S 20 B T.

This corner is on a NE. slope, 75 ft. above creek bottom. Land, mountainous.

Soil, third and fourth rate.

Timber, scattering fir, madrona, alder, yew and cedar.

Dense undergrowth of madrona, mountain-balm, hazel, chinquapin and manzanita.

Mountainous land, or land covered with dense undergrowth, 66.34 chs.
