A Chinquapin, 6 ins. diam., S.50*E., 45 lks. A Laurel, 12 ins. diam., bears S.19*W., 56 lks. This mile crosses Cow Creek bottom and runs into high timbered mountains. Unfit for settlement. Creek bottom 1st rate loam and gravel soil.
