80.00	Set post, cor. to secs. 9, 10, 15, and 16 on E. slope, from which A W. Oak, 10 ins. diam., bears S.29*W., 20 lks. A W. Oak, 10 ins. diam., bears N.69*W., 326 lks. A B. Oak, 18 ins. diam., bears S.52*E., 260 lks. No tree near NE. Surface rolling with high hills on the North. Timber, Pine and Oak openings. Soil, 2nd rate gravelly loam.	+150
