

## Subdivisional Lines T. 32 S., R. 5 W.,

CHAINS	
	S.89*45'E. on a random line bet. secs. 5 and 8. Ascend mountain slope, covered heavily with timber.
40.00	Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
79.62	Intersect N. and S. line 15 lks. N. of cor. of secs. 4, 5, 8 and 9; thence I run N.89*39'W. on true line, bet. secs. 5 and 8. Ascend sharply mountain ridge, covered heavily with timber.
5.40	Top of mountain ridge, bears N. and S., 180 ft. above sec. cor.; begin steep descent of a rocky W. mountain slope.
18.25	A Stream, 2 lks. wide, C. SW., 300 ft. below top of ridge; begin ascent of steep S. slope.
39.81	Set a granitestone 14x10x8 ins., 10 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on N. side, from which A Fir, 5 ins. diam. bears N.17*W., 27 lks. Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S. 5 B. T. A Fir, 12 ins. diam. bears S.49*W., 19 lks. Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S. 8 B.T. This cor. stands near a bottom of a ravine, continue ascending.
44.30	Top of spur, bears N. and S.; 75 ft. above $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. begin descending mountain slope, covered densely with small laurels and firs.
49.80	Enter large fir, cedar and sugar pine timber.
68.30	A dry ravine, bears NE. and SW.; begin ascent.
74.30	Top of spur, bears NE. and SW., begin descent of SW. slope of mountain.
79.62	The cor. of secs. 5, 6, 7 and 8; 350 ft. below mountain spur 44.30 chs. Land mountainous and rough. Soil gravelly and rocky; 3rd and 4th rate. Timber, fir, sugar pine, cedar, laurel. Undergrowth, small firs, small laurels, hazel. Mountainous or heavily timbered Land 79.62 chs.
