CHAINS

- 40.00 Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
- 42.00 Creek, 3 lks. wide, course South.
Steep ascent to
- 65.00 Top of spur, course South.
- 80.60 Intersect East Boundary of Township, 80 lks. South of cor. to secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12, which is a post 4 ins. sq., firmly set in the ground and marked, T 32 S R 5 W S 6, on NE. S 7 on SE. S 12 on SW. and T 32 S R 6 W S 1 on NW. faces with 5 notches on S. and 1 notch on N. edges, from which
- A Cedar, 8 ins. diam., bears N.24*E., 59 lks. dist., marked T 32 S R 5 W S 6 BT.
- A Fir, 5 ins. diam., bears S.63*E., 34 lks. dist., marked T 32 S R 5 W S 7 B T.
- A Cedar, 7 ins. diam., bears S.24*W., 56 lks. dist., marked T 32 S R 6 W S 12 B T.
- A Cedar, 8 ins. diam., bears N.36*W., 39 lks. dist., marked T 32 S R 6 W S 1 B T.
- Thence S.89*26*W., on true line between Secs. 1 and 12, with same Va.
- 40.30 Set a Fir, post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. sq., 22 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S. on N. face, from which
- A Fir, 42 ins. diam., bears S.89*E., 53 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.
- An Alder, 5 ins. diam., bears N.42*W., 21 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.
- 80.60 The cor. to secs. 1, 2, 11 and 12.
Land mountainous, 3rd. rate.
Timber, Fir, Pine, Cedar, Laurel and Chinquapin.
Undergrowth same.
