80.00 Set a Laurel post 4 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground, for the cor., to secs. 14, 15, 22 and 23, marked T 32 S R 6 W S 14 on NE. S 23 on SE. S 22 on SW., and S 15 on NW. faces, with 3 notches on S and 2 notches on East, edges, from which

A Laurel, 6 ins. diam., bears N.30°E., 22 lks. dist., marked T 32 S R 6 W S 14 B T.

A Live Oak, 6 ins. diam., bears S.35°E., 16 lks. dist., marked T 32 S R 6 W S 23 B T.

A Laurel, 6 ins. diam., bears S.70°W., 7 lks. dist., marked T 32 S R 6 W S 22 B T.

A Live Oak, 7 ins. diam., bears N.50°W., 23 lks. dist., marked T 32 S R 6 W S 15 B T.
