44.00 Creek, 2 lks. wide, course East.

68.00 Creek, 1 lk. wide, course East.

80.00 Set Laurel post 4 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground, for cor., to secs. 10, 11, 14 and 15, marked T 32 S R 6 W S 11 on NE. S 14 on SE. S 15 on SW., and S 10 on NW. faces, with 4 notches on S. and 2 notches on E. edges, from which

A Laurel, 6 ins. diam., bears N.20*E., 28 lks. dist., marked T 32 S R 6 W S 11 B T.

A Laurel, 10 ins. diam., bears S.30*E., 81 lks. dist., marked T 32 S R 6 W S 14 B T.

A Laurel, 8 ins. diam., bears S.25*W., 13 lks. dist., marked T 32 S R 6 W S 15 B T.

A Laurel, 7 ins. diam., bears N.40*W., 8 lks. dist., marked T 32 S R 6 W S 10 B T.

Land, hilly and rolling.

Soil, 2nd. rate.

Timber, Fir, Pine, Cedar, Laurel and Oak.

Undergrowth, same.

East, on random line between secs. 11 and 14.

Va. 19*E

Descend.

35.00 Enter bottom.

38.00 Old road.

40.00 Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

41.25 Creek, 20 lks. wide, course South.

43.00 Begin ascent.

66.50 Top of ridge, - old trail, course N. and S.

68.00 Begin descent.

79.72 Intersect N. and S. line 36 lks. N. of cor. to secs. 11, 12, 13 and 14.

Thence, N.89*45'W., on true line between secs. 11 and 14, with same Va.
