- 54.10 Creek, 5 lks. wide, course S.
- 73.00 Top of ridge, course S.
- 79.96 Intersect N. and S. line, 48 lks. N. of cor. to secs. 1, 2, 11 and 12.
Thence N.89°39'W., on true line between secs. 2 and 11, with same Va.
