	Enter bottom.
43.50	Creek, 40 lks. wide, course S.
46.00	Trail, course S.
47.00	Begin ascent.
80.60	Intersect N. and S. line 28 lks. S. of cor. to secs. 14, 15 22 and 23. Thence S.89*W., on true line between secs. 15 and 22, with same VA.
40.30	Set a Yew post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S. on N. face, from which A Yew, 7 ins. diam., bears South 23 lks. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T. A Fir, 40 ins. diam., bears N.18*W., 45 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.
80.60	The cor., to secs. 15, 16, 21 and 22. Land, mountainous. Soil, mostly 3rd rate. Narrow valley along creek, 1st rate. Timber, Fir, Pine, Cedar, Laurel, Chinquapin and Oak. Undergrowth same. Mrs. Woods' has a settlement in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of sec. 22, consist- ing of house, barn, orchard and other improvements, value about \$800. Lat. per solar compass 43*43'N.
	North, between secs. 15 and 16. Va. 19*30'E
	Descend along E. side of mountain.
38.50	Creek, 2 lks. wide, course East.
40.00	Set cedar post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S. on W. face, from which A Fir, 48 ins. diam., bears S.72*W., 13 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.
