CHAINS	
80.24	Intersect N. and S. line 22 lks. N. of cor to secs. 8, 9, 16 and 17. Thence N.89°51'W. ^{on} true line between secs. 8 and 17. Va. 18°E
40.12	Set an Oak, post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S. on N. face, from which A Fir, 20 ins. diam., bears, S.40°W., 15 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T. A Fir, 40 ins. diam., bears, N.38°W., 41 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.
80.24	To secs. 7, 8, 17 and 18. Land mountainous. Soil, 3rd, rate. Timber chiefly Fir, and Pine, with some Cedar and Laurel. West on random line between secs. 7 and 18. Va. 19°E
40.00	Steep ascent to Top of mountain. Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
85.76	Intersect W boundary of township 17 lks. S. of cor. to secs. 7, 12, 13 and 18, which is a Cedar post 4 ins. sq., set firmly in the ground and marked T 32 S R 6 W S 7 on NE. S 18 on SE. S 13 on SW and T 32 S R 7 S 12 on NW. faces, with 4 notches on S. and 2 notches on N. edges, from which A Fir, 44 ins. diam., bears, N.10°E., 31 lks. dist., marked T 32 S R 6 W S 7 B T. A Fir, 24 ins. diam., bears, S.8°E., 18 lks. dist., marked T 32 S R 6 W 18 B T. A Fir, 10 ins. diam., bears, S.12°W., 31 lks. dist., marked T 32 S R 7 W S 13 B T. A Fir, 15 ins. diam., bears, N.63°W., 71 lks. dist., marked T 32 S R 7 W S 12 B T. Thence S.89°53'E., on true line between secs. 7 and 18. Va. 18°E
