CHAINS

I begin at the Standard cor. to Tps. 32 S., Ranges 6 and 7 West, Post gone set new post, viz;

An Ash, 48 ins. long 4 ins. sq., 18 ins. for Standard Co to T 32 S R 6 and 7 West, marked S C T 32 S on N R 6 W S 31 on E R 7 W S 36 on W and 6 notches on E N and W faces, from which;

A Pine, 48 ins. diam., bears N.10\*E., 51 lks. dist.

A Willow, 5 ins. diam., bears N.56\*W., 4 lks. dist.

The same being the old witness Trees.

West on South boundary of Sec. 36

Va.18\*30'E

- 1.50 Enter field course N and S
  - 11.00 Leave field course N and S
  - 40.00 Set A Cedar post, 4 feet long, 4 ins. sq., 20 ins. in the ground, for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. Cor. marked S C  $\frac{1}{4}$  S on N face, and from which;
    - A Chinquapin, 8 ins. diam., bears N.18\*E., 32 lks. dist. marked S C  $\frac{1}{4}$  S B T.
    - A Fir, 12 ins. diam., bears S.68\*W., 12 lks. dist. marked S C  $\frac{1}{4}$  S B T.
  - 80.00 Set A Yew post, 4 $\frac{1}{2}$  feet long 4 ins. sq. 20 ins. in the ground, for standard cor. to secs. 35 and 36 marked, S C T 32 S R 7 W on N S 36 on E and S 35 on W; one notch on E and 5 on W from which;
    - A Fir, 24 ins. diam., bears N.30\*E., 14 lks. dist. marked S C T 32 S R 7 W S 36 B T.
    - A Fir, 14 ins. diam., bears N.46\*W., 37 lks. dist. marked S C T 32 S R 7 W S 35 B T.
    - A Fir, 6 ins. diam., bears S.10\*W., 23 lks. dist. marked S C T 33 S R 7 W Sec. 2 B T.
- Land, along valley of creek nearly level.  
 Soil, sandy loam 2nd rate.  
 Timber, chiefly Fir, Cedar, Pine, Yew, Dogwood, Maple and Alder.
