55.00 Begin steep descent.
 67.65 Water ditch, course N.30*E.
 69.00 A Creek, 50 lks. wide course N.30*E., Begin steep ascent.
 80.00 Set A Laurel post, 4½ feet long 4 ins. sq., 18 ins. in the ground, marked T 32 S R 7 W S 18 on NE face, S 19 on SE face, S 24 on SW face, R 8 W S 13 on NW face, for the corner to Sections 13, 18, 19, and 24, from which;

A Laurel, 10 ins. diam., bears N.30*E., 81 lks. dist. marked T 32 S R 7 W S 18 B T.

A Laurel, 5 ins. diam., bears S.12*E., 51 lks. dist. marked T 32 S R 7 W S 19 B T.

A Fir, 6 ins. diam., bears S.55*W., 23 lks. dist. marked T 32 S R 8 W S 24 B T.

A Live Oak, 6 ins. diam., bears N.55*W., 81 lks. dist. marked T 32 S R 8 W S 13 B T.

Land, mountainous and broken.

Soil, clay and gravel 3rd rate.

Timber, chiefly Fir, Pine, Cedar, Laurel and Yew.

Dense undergrowth of same.

North, between Secs. 13 and 18.
