East on Random Line between Secs. 13 and 24.

Va. 18° E

- 5.00 Leave green timber burned timber young growth of Firs.  
 15.00 Top of Ridge, course SW and SE.  
 16.00 Begin descent.  
 40.00 Set temporary  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. Cor.  
 46.50 Creek 2 lks. wide course South. Begin steep ascent.  
 63.00 Top of Ridge course South.  
 80.43 Inter Sec. E. boundary of Township, 217 lks. South  
 of cor. to sections 13, 18, 19, and 24 viz., A Fir  
 post, 4 ins. sq., about 2 feet above ground marked  
 T 32 S R 6 W S 18 on NE S 19 on SE S 24 on SW and  
 T 32 S R 7 W S 13 on NW faces also three notches on  
 N and S Angles of same from which:
- A Laurel, 8 ins. diam., bears N. 85° E., 30 lks.  
 dist. marked T 32 S R 6 W S 18 B T.
- A Laurel, 6 ins. diam., bears S. 30° E., 61 lks.  
 dist. marked T 32 S R 6 W S 19 B T.
- A Pine, 24 ins. diam., bears S. 70° W., 100 lks.  
 dist. marked T 32 S R 7 W S 24 B T.
- A Live Oak, 5 ins. diam., bears N. 45° W., 31 lks.  
 dist. marked T 32 S R 7 W S 13. B T.
- Thence I run  
 S 88° 28' West on a true line between Secs. 13 and 24.  
 Same Va.
- 40.24 Set a Laurel post, 4 feet long 4 ins. sq., 20 ins. in  
 ground marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S on N side for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor.  
 from which:
- A Fir, 10 ins. diam., bears N. 14° E., 17 lks.  
 dist. marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S B T.
- A Laurel, 6 ins. diam., bears S. 27° E., 28 lks.  
 dist. marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S B T.
- 80.43 To corner to Sections 13, 14, 23, and 24.
