Cor. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S on N face from which: A Laurel 6 ins. diam., bears N.10*E., 47 lks. dist. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T. A Laurel, 5 ins. diam., bears S.7*W., 14 lks. dist. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.
