Thence I run S 88*07'W on true line between secs. 1 and 12. Same Va. |
| 39.93 | Set A Yew post, 4 feet long 4 ins. sq., 18 ins. in the ground for the 1/2 sec. cor. marked 1/2 S on N side from which: A Fir, 36 ins. diam bears S.45*E., 10 lks. dist marked 1/2 S B T. A Fir, 36 ins. diam., bears N.45*W., 10 lks. dist. marked 1/2 S B T. |
