CHAINS

East on Random line between Secs. 23 and 26.

Va.17*30'E

34.00 Leave Timber enter Brush Lands steep ascent.

36.00 Top of Ridge course N and S Begin descent.

40.00 Set temporary $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor.

46.00 Dry Ravine course SE Ascend.

53.40 Top of Spur course SE steep descent.

80.27 Intersect Sec.line 25 lks. North of corner to Secs.
23, 24, 25, and 26.

Thence I run

N 89* 49'W on true line between Secs. 23 and 26

Va.18*E

40.14 Set Stone 9X12X12 ins. 8 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec.
Cor. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on N side, and raised a stone mound.

80.27 To corner to Secs. 22, 23, 26 and 27

Land high mountainous and broken.

Timber poor chiefly Fir, Pine cedar and Laurel.

Undergrowth very dense, same Oak, Balm and "Manzanita".

North between Secs. 22 and 23.

40.00 Set Laurel post, 4 feet long 4 ins. sq., 18 ins. in the
ground for the $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S on W side
from which:

A Fir, 22 ins. diam., bears East 50 lks.
marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.

A Cedar 24 ins. diam., bears S.55*W., 16 lks.
dist. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.

80.00 Set Pine post, 4 feet long 4 ins. sq., 22 ins. in the
ground for the corner to Secs. 14, 15, 22 and 23
marked T 32 S R 7 W S 14 on NE S 23 on SE S 22 on SW
and S 15 on NW also three notches on S and two notches
on E Angles from which:
