dist. marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S B T.

80.09 To cor. to Secs. 2, 3, 11 and 12

Land mountainous and hilly.

Soil 3rd rate.

Timber good chiefly Fir, Pine, Cedar, Laurel, Shinquapin  
and Yew.

Undergrowth very dense same and Live Oak.

North on Random line between Secs. 2 and 3

Va.19\*E

33.50 Top of Spur course NE Trail.

40.00 Set temporary  $\frac{1}{2}$  sec.cor.

62.23 Creek 5 lks wide course NE

82.23 Intersect N boundary of Township, 65 lks E of corner to  
Secs. 2, 3, 34 and 35 viz.,

A Fir post, firmly set in ground 4 ins. sq., marked  
T 31 S R 7 W S 35 on NE T 32 S S 2 on SE S 3 on SW  
and S 34 on NW also 2 notches on the E and 4 on  
W angles of same, from which:

A Laurel, 8 ins. diam., bears N.12\*E., 71 lks.  
dist. marked T 31 S R 7 W S 35 B T

A Laurel, 6 ins. diam., bears S.85\*E., 21 lks.  
dist. marked T 32 S R 7 W S 2 B T.

A Laurel, 14 ins. diam., bears S.60\*W., 6 lks.  
dist. marked T 32 S R 7 W S 3 B T.

A Fir, 26 ins. diam., bears N.54\*W., 109 lks.  
dist. marked T 31 S R 7 W S 34 B T.

Thence I run

S 0\*28' E on true line between Secs. 2 and 3

Va.18\*E

42.23 Set A Fir post, 4 feet long 22 ins. in ground 4 ins. sq.,  
marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S on W side for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. Cor. from which:

A Fir, 40 ins. diam., bears East 36 lks.

dist marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S B T.
