CHAINS

Secs. 19, 24, 25 and 30 viz.,

A Fir post, 4 ins. sq., permanently set in the ground, marked T 32 S R 7 W S 19 on NE, S 30 on SE, S 25 on SW and T 32 S R 8 W S 24 on NW faces, also 2 notches on S and 4 notches on N angles of same. from which;

A Fir, 16 ins. diam., bears N.16°E., 37 lks.
marked T 32 S R 7 W S 19 B T.

A Fir, 20 ins. diam., bears S.30°E., 84 lks.
marked T 32 S R 7 W S 30 B T

A Laurel, 5 ins. diam., bears S.35°W., 19 lks.
marked T 32 S R 8 W S 25 B T.

A Pine, 28 ins. diam., bears N.6°W., 35 lks.
marked T 32 S R 8 W S 24 B T.

41.10 Set A Pine, post 4 feet long 4 ins. diam., 18 ins. in the ground, marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S on N side, for the $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor. from which;

A Laurel, 4 ins. diam., bears North 4 lks. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.

A Laurel, 4 ins. diam., bears South 4 lks.
marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.

81.10 To corner to Secs. 19, 20, 29 and 30

Land, mountainous and broken.

Soil, rocky 4th rate.

Timber, poor chiefly Fir, Pine, Cedar and Laurel.

Undergrowth same, and Live Oak, Balm and "Manzanita".

North between Secs. 19 and 20

Va.19°E.

15.00 Begin steep descent.

22.50 Cow Creek, 200 lks. wide course W

26.00 Steep ascent to

28.00 Trail course E and W gradual ascent.
