

Subdivisions of Tp. 32, S., R 7 W.

CHAINS

- A Cedar post, 4 ins. sq., firmly set in the ground, marked T 32 S R 7 W S 6 on NE S 7 on SE S 12 on the SW and R 8 W S 1 on the NW face, also 5 notches on S and one on N angles of same, from which;
- A Pine, 45 ins. diam., bears N.80°E., 6 lks. marked T 32 S R 7 W S 6 B T.
- A Pine, 14 ins. diam., bears S.50°E., 140 lks. marked T 32 S R 7 W S 7 B T.
- A Fir, 22 ins. diam., bears S.8°W., 66 lks. marked T 32 S R 8 W S 12 B T.
- A Fir, 20 ins. diam., bears N.45°W., 123 lks. marked T 32 S R 8 W S 1 B T.
- Thence I run
N.89°48'E on true line between Secs. 6 and 7
Va.18°E.
- 42.25 Set A Cedar post, 4 feet long 4 ins. sq., 20 ins. in the ground, marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S on N side, for the $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor. from which;
- A Pine, 40 ins. diam., bears S.73°W., 17 lks. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T
- A Pine, 48 ins. diam., bears N.35°W., 57 lks. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.
- 82.25 To the corner to Sections 5, 6, 7 and 8
Land, rolling and sloping South.
Soil, clay, and loam 2nd rate.
Timber, good chiefly Pine, Fir, Cedar, and Laurel.
Underbrush same.
- North on Random line between Secs. 5 and 6
Va.19°E.
- Ascent.
- 24.50 Top of Ridge course E and W
- 26.00 Begin steep descent.
- 40.00 Set temporary $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor.
- 44.20 Creek, 2 lks. wide course N.10°E.
- 76.00 Creek, 3 lks. wide course NW
