

Retracement of the 7th Standard Parallel  
South through Range 7 West.

CHAINS

- 45.00 Leave burnt timber; enter green timber, bears N and S  
continue a rough and rocky descend.
- 58.00 A Rocky gulch 5 lks. wide course NE 150 ft. below  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec.  
cor. begin a very steep ascent of a rocky SE  
mountain slope.
- 71.67 The closing cor. of Tp.33 South, ranges 7 and 8 W  
this cor. is 200 ft. above dry gulch.
- Land, mountainous.
- Soil, gravelly and rocky 3rd and 4th rate.
- Timber, Fir, Cedar, Pine, and Laurel.
- Undergrowth, small Live and Burr Oaks. Chinquapin.
- Whole line of Sec. 6 is  $9.15 + 71.67$  chs = 80.82 chs.
