- 40.00 Set a Fir post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. sq., 20 ins. in the ground for the 1/4 sec. cor. marked 1/4 on West side, and from which
 - A Fir, 48 ins. diam., bears N.71*E., 65 lks. dist.
Marked 1/4 S B T.
 - A Sugar Pine, 36 ins. diam., bears N.36*W., 42 lks. dist.
Marked 1/4 S B T.
- 45.00 A dry ravine, course East, ascend.
- 52.50 Top of spur, course East, steep descent.
