A Fir, 15 ins. diam., bears N.68°E., 35 lks. dist.

Marked S C T 32 S R 8 W S 36 B T.

A Laurel, 8 ins. diam., bears S.52°E., 34 lks. dist.

Marked S C T 33 S R 8 W B T.

A Fir, 15 ins. diam., bears N.24°W., 28 lks. dist.

Marked T 32 S R 8 W S 35 B T.

Va. 20°E.

Ascend.

10.00 High spur, course West, descend.

36.25 A creek, 6 lks. wide, course North 60°W. Steep ascent.

40.00 Set a stone 14x12x6 ins., 10 ins. in the ground for  $\frac{1}{4}$   
sec. cor. marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  on West face from

A Live Oak, 7 ins. diam., bears N.66°W., 33 lks. dist.

Marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S B T.

Ascend SW slope of mountain.

80.00 Set a Laurel post 4 ft. long, 4 ins. sq. 24 ins. in the  
ground for cor. to secs. 25, 26, 35, and 36.

Marked T 32 S R 8 W S 25 on NE. S 36 on the SE S 35  
on SW and S 26 on North W. faces with one notch on  
the South and East edges, from which

A Laurel, 10 ins. diam., bears N.40°E., 52 lks. dist.

Marked T 32 S R 8 W S 25 B T.

A Fir, 36 ins. diam., bears S.80°E., 21 lks. dist.
