 A Fir, 40 ins. diam., bears S.68\*W., 17 lks. dist.  
 Marked T 32 S R 8 W S 35 B T.  
 A Laurel, 14 ins. diam., bears N.50\*W., 60 lks. dist.  
 Marked T 32 S R 8 W S 26 B T.  
 Land, mountainous and broken  
 Soil, rocky and clay, 4th rate.  
 Timber, chiefly Fir, Pine, Cedar, Laurel, Chinquapin,  
 and Live Oak.  
 Undergrowth, thick and densely covered of Live Oak,  
 Laurel, Balm, and Manzanita.

East, on a random line between Secs. 25 and 36.  
 Va.20\*E.

Gradual ascent along SW slope.

- 23.50 Top of ridge, course North and South. Descend.
- 40.00 Set temp.  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec..cor.
- 57.75 A creek, 4 lks. wide, course NE.
- 75.00 A creek, 2 lks. wide, course NE.
- 80.30 Intersect East bdy. of the Tp., 28 lks. North of the cor.  
 to secs. 25, 30, 31, and 36, which is  
 A Fir, 28 ins. diam., marked T 32 S R 7 W S 30 on NE  
 S 31 on SE. S 36 on SW and R 8 W S 25 on NW faces  
 also 1 notch on the South and 5 notches on the North  
 angles of the same, and from which  
 A Fir, 18 ins. diam., bears N.68\*E., 70 lks. dist.

 A Fir, 10 ins. diam., bears N.82\*W., 100 lks. dist.
