CHAINS

Timber, scattering of Fir, Pine, and Laurel.  
Undergrowth, densely covered and thick of Laurel, Balm,  
Chinquapin, Live Oak, and Huckleberry.

East, on random line between Secs. 12 and 13.  
Va. 19\*45'E.

Steep descent.

14.50 A creek, 2 lks. wide, course NE.

20.40 A creek, 2 lks. wide, course NE.

40.00 Set temp.  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor.

52.00 Steep descent.

80.23 Intersect the E bdy. of Township 22 lks. N of the cor.  
to secs. 7, 12, 13, and 18, which is a Laurel post,  
4 ins. sq. firmly set in the ground and marked T 32  
S R 7 W S 7 on the NE; S 18 on the SE R 8 W S 13 on  
SW and S 12 on NW faces with 4 notches on South and 2  
notches on the N angles of same, and from which  
A Fir, 36 ins. diam., bears N.48\*E., 15 lks. dist.  
Marked T 32 S R 7 W S 7 B T.  
A Pine, 15 ins. diam., bears S.30\*E., 53 lks. dist.  
Marked T 32 S R 7 W S 18 B T.  
A Fir, 20 ins. diam., bears S.5\*W., 64 lks. dist.  
Marked T 32 S R 8 W S 13 B T.  
A Laurel, 10 ins. diam., bears N.28\*W., 40 lks. dist.  
Marked T 32 S R 8 W S 12 B T.

Thence I run.

N.89\*51'W. on true line between secs. 12 and 13.  
Va. same.

40.12 A Fir, 24 ins. diam., which I mark  $\frac{1}{2}$  S on the N side for  
the  $\frac{1}{2}$  sec. cor., and from which  
A Fir, 18 ins. diam., bears N.60\*E.50 lks. dist.  
Marked  $\frac{1}{2}$  S B T.  
A Fir, 18 ins. diam., bears S.89\*E., 25 lks. dist.
