CHAINS

North, on random line between secs. 2 and 3.

Va. 19°45'E.

Ascend.

15.00 Trail to Jackass.

16.00 Top of ridge, course S.80°E., steep descent.

40.00 Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. along NE slope of mountain.

80.40 Intersect North bdy. of tp. 76 lks. West of cor. to secs. 2, 3, 34 and 35, which is a stone firmly set in the ground and marked with 2 notches on the E and 4 notches on the W angles of same, and from which

A Fir, 14 ins. diam., bears N.82°E., 57 lks. dist.

Marked T 31 S R 8 W S 35 B T.

A Fir, 14 ins. diam., bears S.65°E., 41 lks. dist.

Marked T 32 S R 8 W S 2 B T.

A Fir, 16 ins. diam., bears S.28°W., 30 lks. dist.

Marked T 32 S R 8 W S 3 B T.

A Fir, 13 ins. diam., bears N.35°W., 42 lks. dist.

Marked T 31 S R 8 W S 34 B T.

40.40 Set a Laurel post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. sq., 20 ins in the ground for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S on W side, and from which

A Fir, 14 ins. diam., bears S.70°E., 44 lks. dist.

Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.

A Fir, 16 ins. diam., bears N.50°W., 15 lks. dist.

Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.

80.40 The cor. to secs. 2, 3, 10 and 11.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, 3rd rate.

Timber, dense, chiefly of Fir, Pine, Laurel, and Cedar.

Undergrowth, thick of Laurel, Fir, Balm and Huckleberry.

From the cor. to secs. 33 and 34 on the S bdy. of the tp.
