CHAINS	
4.00	Top of ridge, course North. Trail to Rogue River. Descend.
36.00	Enter creek, 2 lks. wide, from NW, course East.
40.00	Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
43.00	Leave creek, course S.80°E.
46.40	A creek, 5 lks. wide, course East, rolling ridges.
80.14	Intersect N and S line 32 lks S of the cor. to secs. 22, 23, 26, and 27. Thence I run. S.89°46'W. on a true line between secs. 22 and 27. Va. same.
40.07	A sugar Pine, 60 ins. diam. for $\frac{1}{4}$ cor. which I marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on N side, and from which A Fir, 48 ins. diam., bears S.10°E., 40 lks. dist. Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T. A Fir, 36 ins. diam., bears N.70°W., 18 lks. dist. Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.
80.14	The cor. to secs. 21, 22, 27, and 28. Land, mountainous. Soil, 3rd rate. Timber, dense, of Fir, Pine, Laurel, Chinquapin, and Cedar. Undergrowth, thick, Fir, Laurel, Chinquapin, Live Oak, Balm, and Hazel. June 26, 1883
40.00	North, between secs. 21 and 22. Va.19°45'E. A Fir, 36 ins. diam., which I mark $\frac{1}{4}$ S on W side for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., and from which A Pine, 30 ins. diam., bears S.40°E., 27 lks. dist. Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T. A Fir, 36 ins. diam., bears S.52°W., 49 lks. dist. Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.
50.50	A creek, 3 lks. wide, course NW. Ascend.
60.00	Top of spur, course West. Steep descent.
64.20	A creek, 2 lks. wide, course West. Ascend.
