80.00	<p>A Laurel, 5 ins. diam., which I marked T 32 S R 8 W S 15 on NE, S 22 on SE, S 21 on SW, and S 16 on NW, faces also three notches on E and S angles of same for the cor. to secs. 15, 16, 21, and 22, from which</p> <p>A Chinquapin, 6 ins. diam. bears N.30*E., 46 lks. dist. Marked T 32 S R 8 W S 15 B T.</p> <p>A Laurel, 6 ins. diam., bears S.1*E., 24 lks. dist. Marked T 32 S R 8 W S 22 B T.</p> <p>A Laurel, 6 ins. diam., bears S.68*W., 14 lks. dist. Marked T 32 S R 8 W S 21 B T.</p> <p>A Laurel, 6 ins. diam., bears N.52*W., 25 lks. dist. Marked T 32 S R 8 W S 16 B T.</p> <p>Land, mountainous. Sloping West. Soil, rocky, 3rd, and 4th rate. Timber, dense, Fir, Pine, Cedar, and Laurel. Undergrowth, thick, Fir, Laurel, Vine Maple, Live Oak, and Balm.</p>
