

Subdivisions of T. 32 S., R. 8 W.

CHAINS

Land, mountainous.  
Soil, 3rd rate.  
Timber, densely covered with forests of Fir and Pine.  
Undergrowth, thick, Fir, Laurel, Live Oak, and Balm.  
June 29, 1883.

Beginning at the Standard corner to secs. 32 and 33 on the South bdy. of the tp. which is a stone 14x12x8 ins. marked S C. with 4 notches on E and 2 notches on W edges and from which a Pine 10 ins. diam., bears N. 14\*E., 40 lks. dist. Marked T 32 S R 8 W S 33 B T.  
A Fir, 12 ins. diam., bears S.42\*E., 40 lks. dist.  
Marked T 33 S R 8 W S 4 B T  
A Fir, 5 ins. diam., bears N.64\*W., 67 lks. dist.  
Marked T 32 S R 8 W S 32 B T.

Thence I ran.  
North, between secs. 32 and 33.

Va.20\*E.

Ascend. SE slope of mountain.

21.50 Top of ridge, course NE. Descend NW slope.

40.00 Set a Fir post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. sq., 20 ins. in the ground marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S on W side for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., and from which

A Fir, 36 ins. diam., bears S.64\*E., 46 lks. dist.  
Marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S B T.

A Pine, 30 ins. diam., bears N.78\*W., 34 lks. dist.  
Marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S B T.

68.25 A creek, 6 lks. wide, course East. Steep ascent.

80.00 Set a Live Oak post 4 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground for the cor. to secs. 28, 29, 32, and 33. Marked T 32 S R 8 W S 28 on NE, S 33 on SE, S 32 on SW, and S 29 on NW, faces also 4 notches on the E, and 1 notch on S angles of same, and from which  
A Laurel, 8 ins. diam., bears N.74\*E., 71 lks. dist.  
Marked T 32 S R 8 W S 28 B T.
